# HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP AND LAPTOP AWARDS 2024

Application Deadline: Friday, April 12, 2024 | 4:00 pm CST



Thank you for your interest in submitting an application for the Greater Milwaukee Urban League's **High School Graduate Scholarship and Laptop Awards 2024**. We congratulate you on your decision to continue your education by attending college or serving in the military. Our goal is to invest financial resources to help support your journey.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

## To be eligible for consideration for this award, an applicant must:

- Be a Milwaukee County college-bound high school senior or early graduating junior who will graduate in May or June 2024.
- 2. Show evidence [i.e., acceptance letter(s)] for plans for full-time enrollment in a two or four-year college program.]
- 3. Be able to attend a "Red Carpet" acceptance event on Wednesday, June 12 at 6:00 pm and sign a media release form.
- 4. Meet the specific requirements of **ONE** of the following three categories:
  - Category 1 Academic Excellence: Applicants in this category must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and show excellence in core curriculum subjects throughout your 3/4 years of high school. Applicants in this category will also be required to submit two (2) letters of recommendation that highlight and confirm intellectual curiosity and exemplary academic achievement, a transcript, and an essay (minimum of 400 words see Required Application Materials).
  - Category 2 Community Service/Leadership: Applicants in this category must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher and demonstrate active participation in extra-curricular activities, especially community service activities and/or display leadership abilities in school activities or through work experience. Applicants in this category will also be required to submit two (2) letters of recommendation that highlight and confirm exemplary community service/leadership, a transcript, a list of involvement in community service/volunteer activity and/or leadership roles/positions and an essay (minimum of 400 words see Required Application Materials).

• Category 3 – Character/Academic Turnaround:
Applicants in this category must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher and have faced adversity and/or overcome challenging life circumstances. The nominee must have turned his/her school performance around or must have maintained high academic standards in the face of adversity. Applicants in this category will be required to submit (2) two letters of recommendation from their school administration, guidance counselor, minister/clergy or a community organization (i.e., Boys and Girls Club, Boy or Girl Scouts, YWCA, etc.), a transcript, and an essay (minimum of 350 words - see Application Requirements).

**Please note:** Priority will be given to students in each category who demonstrate financial need through eligibility for Free or Reduced Lunch.

#### **AWARD TIMELINE**

The following are the key dates to adhere to:

- \* Friday, April 12: Application deadline 4:00 pm (this is a firm deadline; no exceptions).
- \* Friday, May 24: Award notification via email/USPS (Make sure your email/phone number is current!)
- **Wednesday, June 12 :** Award presentation at the Milwaukee County Zoo, Peck Center

**Please note:** All awardees must be in attendance to receive their awards. Failure to attend the designated appointment time will result in forfeiture of the award.

#### **SELECTION COMMITTEE AND PROCESS**

The Greater Milwaukee Urban League has an outstanding group of community volunteers who sit on the High School Graduate Scholarship and Laptop Awards Selection Committee which reviews all applications. The committee is comprised of local professionals including educators, businessmen and women, and individuals who are considered experts in their field. All members share a passion for the post-secondary success of youth in the community. Additionally, each committee member commits to equality and fairness in the review of applications and selecting finalists who best fit the Award criteria.

Each member of the High School Graduate Scholarship and Laptop Awards Selection Committee will be assigned applications for reviewing and scoring. Applicants with the highest scores and percentage in each category will be awarded a laptop, and/or scholarship. Decisions of the Award Committee are FINAL.

#### **EVALUATION CRITERIA BY CATEGORY**

Applicants for the High School Graduate Scholarship and Laptop Awardswill be evaluated in **one of the three (3)** designated categories mentioned above, and reviewed again as follows:

1. Category 1 - Academic Excellence: Applicants in this category will be evaluated on the quality of their high school transcript and grade point average in the specific areas of Mathematics, Science and English, and overall evidence of adequate preparation for college enrollment and future academic success, letters of recommendation, and essay.

#### 2. Category 2 - Community Service/Leadership:

Applicants in this category will be evaluated on the scope of his/her active participation in extra-curricular activities, especially community service activities (i.e., volunteer work at school, church and/or community-based organization(s) and/or evidence of an applicant's involvement in particular activities as listed on the Community Involvement Form, that demonstrate a strong desire to positively impact others and contribute to society as a leader, recommendation letters and essay.

### 3. Category 3 – Character/Academic Turnaround:

Applicants in this category will be evaluated on their "turnaround" as a student in terms of their character and/or academic performance and overall significant growth as a student as evidenced on their transcript, letters of recommendation and essay.

- 1. Global warming
- 2. Wars Iraq/Israel, Russia/Ukraine
- 3. Loss of Diversity Programming in institutions of higher learning and employment
- 4. Women's rights to abortion- Women's rights to reproductive health care/abortion.
- 5. Restrictions on voting

**Answers must be a minimum of 400 words**, and be specific in your "why" and "how." (i.e., "Why" this is important to you, and "How" you would address it.)

\*If you have participated in any of the following youth programs with GMUL, such as Project Ready Mentor, Urban Youth Pathways, Graduate to Employment, Microsoft Certification, or Road Ready Youth Driver's Education and you will automatically qualify for a laptop.

\*Students who have received a laptop from another organization will not be considered for an additional laptop.

#### **EVALUATION CRITERIA BY CATEGORY**

Applicants for the **Greater Milwaukee Urban League High School Graduate Scholarship and Laptop Awards 2024** will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Submission of the full application with the checklist. 10%
- 2. **Recommendation Letters**: Two (2) signed letters of recommendation from a teacher or school staff person(s) or from community representatives **20**%
- 3. **Official Transcript (if available) in a Sealed Envelope (if mailed)**: All transcripts must include information on applicant's most recent available grade period and reflect a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. **20%**
- 4. Essay question: Clarity, grammar, punctuation, organization, depth of content and compassion displayed in the essay question will account for the bulk of the scoring. 50%
- 5. Category 2 Community Service/Leadership Verification Form- Additional- 5%
