To be eligible for consideration for this award, an applicant must:

- Be a Milwaukee County college-bound high school senior or early graduating Junior who will graduate in **May or June 2022**.
- Show evidence [i.e., acceptance letter(s)] or plans for full-time enrollment in a two or four-year college program in the following states: **Wisconsin, Alabama or Mississippi**.

- Be able to attend a "Red Carpet" Reception on **Tuesday, June 14, 2022, at 6:00 pm**, at **TBD** and sign a media release form.
- **ANSWER ONE (1) OF THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS** (minimum of 350 words):
- Our society is facing many challenges that affect the underserved. What are one or two issues that you would advocate for the betterment of your community? Explain your challenge(s), and what action(s) would you take to advocate.
- What have you done during your high school experience that demonstrates your belief in community service, and what motivated this commitment to service?

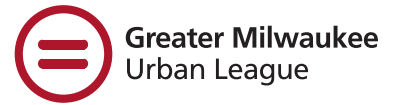

- Essay:** Please select one of the following questions to answer in a minimum of:
 - Our society is facing many challenges that affect the underserved. What are one or two issues that you would advocate for the betterment of your community?
 - What have you done during your high school experience that demonstrates your belief in community service, and what motivated this commitment to service?
- Recommendation Letters:** Two (2) signed letters of recommendation from school administration, teacher or school staff person(s) or from community representatives (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.) who can attest to applicant's qualifications for the selected category (1,2, or 3). Letters from family members or friends are not acceptable.
- Applicant's essay **must state essay question** as the title/heading and be neatly typed in Arial or Times New Roman, 12-point font, double-spaced, with applicant's name, contact information, high school, and word count in the top right corner of each page. **(Minimum 350 words)**
- Official Transcript (if available) emailed or mailed in a Sealed Envelope:** All transcripts must include information on applicant's most recent available grade period and reflect a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Only transcripts that are stamped or embossed with the high school's official seal and submitted in a sealed envelope (if mailing) will be accepted.

SELECTION COMMITTEE AND PROCESS

The Greater Milwaukee Urban League and Kohler Co. have an outstanding group of community volunteers and company associates who make up the Review Committee for **all** applications. All members share a passion for the post-secondary success of youth in the community. Additionally, each committee member commits to equality and fairness in the review of applications and selecting finalists who best fit the Award criteria.

Each member of the Review Committee will be assigned applications for reviewing and scoring. Applicants with the highest scores will be awarded one of **10 - \$1,000.00 Greater Milwaukee Urban League and Kohler Co. Scholarships.** **Decisions of the Award Committee are final.**

EVALUATION CRITERIA BY CATEGORY

Applicants for the **Greater Milwaukee Urban League and Kohler Scholarships** will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. Submission of the full application with the checklist. – **10%**
 2. **Recommendation Letters:** Two (2) signed letters of recommendation from a teacher or school staff person(s) or from community representatives (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.) who can attest to applicant's qualifications for the selected category (1, 2, or 3.) Letters written by family members or friends are not acceptable. – **30%**
 3. **Official Transcript (if available) in a Sealed Envelope (if mailed):** All transcripts must include information on applicant's most recent available grade period and reflect a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Only transcripts that are stamped or embossed with the high school's official seal and submitted via email or mailed in a sealed envelope will be accepted. - **10%**
 4. **Essay question: Clarity, grammar, punctuation, organization, depth of content and compassion displayed in the essay question – will account for the bulk of the scoring. - 50%**
