SELECTION COMMITTEE AND PROCESS

The Greater Milwaukee Urban League and Kohler Co. have an outstanding group of community volunteers and company associates who make up the Review Committee for all applications. All members share a passion for the post-secondary success of youth in the community. Additionally, each committee member commits to equality and fairness in the review of applications and selecting finalists who best fit the Award criteria.

Each member of the Review Committee will be assigned applications for reviewing and scoring. Applicants with the highest scores will be awarded one of 10 - \$1,000.00 Greater Milwaukee Urban League and Kohler Co. Scholarships. Decisions of the Award Committee are final.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applicants for the Greater Milwaukee Urban League and Kohler Scholarships will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Submission of the full application with the checklist. 10%
- 2. **Recommendation Letters**: Two (2) signed letters of recommendation from a teacher or school staff person(s) or from community representatives (for example: clergy, employer, youth group leader, etc.) who can attest to applicant's qualifications for the selected category (1, 2, or 3.) Letters written by family members or friends are not acceptable. – 20%
- 3. Official Transcript (required) in a Sealed Envelope (if mailed): All transcripts must include information on applicant's most recent available grade period and reflect a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale. Only transcripts that are stamped or embossed with the high school's official seal and submitted via email or mailed in a sealed envelope will be accepted. - 10%
- 4. Essay question: Clarity, grammar, punctuation, organization, depth of content and compassion displayed in the essay question - will account for the bulk of the scoring. - 50%
- 5. College acceptance letter 10%

To be eligible for consideration for the 2023 GMUL and Kohler Scholarship, applicants must complete and submit all required documents by 4:00 PM CST, Wednesday, May 3, 2023, and if mailed must be postmarked with this date:
